Another Lent and Easter season has come and gone. And wasn't it a joyous Easter day as we gathered to celebrate the glorious good news of the empty tomb! We have this six-week buildup

to Easter and then this amazing outpouring of joy and celebration . . . and now what!

Is there a letdown after Easter? Do we fall right back into our usual patterns of life and forget why we did all that celebrating? And thanks to Chris and the choir for helping us continue our celebration with the amazing presentation of *Messiah*.

But we women at the tomb were urged to do, we too, are charged to "Go and Tell!" We must go and tell the good news.

In one of the more interesting passages of the New Testament, we find the story of the women at the tomb. "He is gone before you to Galilee, as he said to you." "Where you will find him." What is the significance of pointing out the fact that he is going to Galilee? Looking at the story in context, it seems that this is less about a

specific place and more about a direction to a particular kind of activity.

Galilee is the place of Jesus' ministry among the "least." There he crossed over the boundaries that separated the clean from the unclean. There he ate with tax collectors and sinners, and proclaimed that all God's children are holy.

So, what is the message that we are to take from this directive? It seems that the message is that in order to truly have an encounter with the risen Lord, to truly know the risen Lord, to truly see the risen Lord, we have to participate in a ministry like that of Jesus and his followers in Galilee.

The church is not only called to worship at the feet of the risen Lord. The church is called to go in joy, to go and tell, and to continue Jesus' work of calling all of God's children to the service and worship of God.

Jesus' promise is that in this work the disciples - we - will

see him. And the promise is still true - that as we follow Jesus' mission, as we go and tell in all our joy and fear, we too will see him, and we will know him to be our resurrected and living Lord.

And so as April turns over into May, how do we live this out in our day to day existence? We live it out by continuing our joyful worship and praise of the risen Lord. As I said recently, every Sunday is Easter Sunday!

We live out our calling also by continuing to care for those who are in need. We care for our homebound members with visits and calls and cards. We care for the sick as we see fit. We pray for those who are in need of our prayers. We care.

And we continue to live out our calling by participating in the 2017 West Virginia Mission Trip. We will be going to a different location than the past years, and working this summer. We will be giving more information about our trip in the next issue of the journal. If you are interested, let me know. The dates are July 16-20, and the location is Colcord, WV.

And so my challenge to you is to continue to be resurrection people! Continue to revel in the unbelievable good news of the empty tomb. And continue to reach out in love as we go to all the Galilees of the world. May Eastertide of 2017 be a joyful time for each of you. Grace & Peace,







New Boiler Being Installed!

Bethany has been a buzz of activity this last week of April as our new boiler is in the process of being installed. The pictures below show the old one, showing the wear and tear of 40+ years of service having been removed in sections, and the new one ready to be installed. If everything goes as planned, the installation should be complete within a week, with state inspections to follow. Then we'll be ready for next winter!

Everyone should have received a letter with information about this project, and the costs involved. As was shared in the letter, although capital funds are available, we don't want to deplete those as we anticipate other possible major projects this year. Total cost of the new boiler is around \$28,000. We are



requesting donations to help offset this cost.

You can see the thermometer graph that shows our goal

(\$28,000) and what has been collected so far (\$6,315). Each month we hope to see the red rise on up to our goal!




