

As the threat of the pandemic does ease somewhat, we are still not completely out of the woods. Recently the CDC adjusted the guidelines for wearing masks, suggesting that all persons - vaccinated or not - wear masks indoors in areas that are experiencing more infections. After Session met, we are now asking our congregation to wear a mask in worship, always remembering our hope to keep all worshippers healthy and free from infection.
